**Remuneration Tribunal (Amendment) Bill
1998**

A BILL

FOR

An Act to amend the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Remuneration Tribunal (Amendment) Act 1998*.

2. Commencement

This Act shall be taken to have commenced on 21 February 1998.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, "Principal Act" means the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995*.

4. Inquiries in relation to members of the Legislative Assembly

Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end the following subsection:

- 5 “(3) For the purposes of paragraph (g) of the definition of ‘office’ in subsection 73 (1) of the *Australian Capital Territory (Self-Government) Act 1988* of the Commonwealth, each of the following offices is declared to be an office to which section 73 of that Act applies:
- 10 (a) Leader of the Opposition in the Legislative Assembly;
- (b) Deputy Leader of the Opposition in the Legislative Assembly;
- (c) Government Whip in the Legislative Assembly;
- (d) Opposition Whip in the Legislative Assembly;
- (e) the presiding member (however designated) of a committee of the Legislative Assembly.”
