# Remuneration Tribunal (Amendment) Bill 1998

#### A BILL

FOR

### An Act to amend the Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

#### 1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Remuneration Tribunal (Amendment)
Act 1998.

#### 2. Commencement

This Act shall be taken to have commenced on 21 February 1998.

#### 3. Principal Act

In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Remuneration Tribunal Act o 1995.

#### 4. Inquiries in relation to members of the Legislative Assembly

Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end the following subsection:

- For the purposes of paragraph (g) of the definition of 'office' in 5 subsection 73 (1) of the Australian Capital Territory (Self-Government) Act 1988 of the Commonwealth, each of the following offices is declared to be an office to which section 73 of that Act applies:
  - Leader of the Opposition in the Legislative Assembly;
  - (b) Deputy Leader of the Opposition in the Legislative Assembly;
  - Government Whip in the Legislative Assembly; (c)
  - (d) Opposition Whip in the Legislative Assembly;
  - the presiding member (however designated) of a committee of the Legislative Assembly.".
