## **Public Place Names Amendment Bill 2002**

### **A Bill for**

An Act to amend the *Public Place Names Act 1989*, and for other purposes

---

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 **1 Name of Act**

2 This Act is the *Public Place Names Amendment Act 2002*.

3 **2 Commencement**

4 This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

5 *Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on  
6 the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

7 **3 Acts amended**

8 (1) This Act (other than section 6) amends the *Public Place Names Act*  
9 *1989*.

10 (2) Section 6 amends the *Districts Act 2002*.

11 **4 Minister to determine names**

16 (2) If the Minister is making a determination about the naming of a

20 places have been named in the last 10 years; and

21 (b) whether the names of women are well-represented.
