Duties Amendment Bill 2008 (No 2)

A Bill for

An Act to amend the *Duties Act 1999*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 **1 Name of Act**

2 This Act is the *Duties Amendment Act 2008 (No 2)*.

3 **2 Commencement**

4 This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

5 *Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on
6 the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

7 **3 Legislation amended**

8 This Act amends the *Duties Act 1999*.

9 **4 Rate of duty**
10 **New section 208 (3)**

- 12 (3) A determination for this section made under the *Taxation*
13 *Administration Act 1999*, section 139 may apply, adopt or
14 incorporate an instrument as in force from time to time.

18 *Note 1* The text of an applied, adopted or incorporated instrument, whether
19 applied as in force from time to time or at a particular time, is taken to
20 be a notifiable instrument if the operation of the Legislation Act,
21 s 47 (5) or (6) is not disappplied (see s 47 (7)).

22 *Note 2* A notifiable instrument must be notified under the Legislation Act.

23 *Note 3* An example is part of the Act, is not exhaustive and may extend, but
24 does not limit, the meaning of the provision in which it appears (see
25 Legislation Act, s 126 and s 132).
