An Act to amend the Duties Act 1999

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1	1	Name of Act
2		This Act is the Duties Amendment Act 2012 (No 2).
3	2	Commencement
4		This Act commences on the day after its notification day.
5 6		Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).
7	3	Legislation amended
8		This Act amends the Duties Act 1999.
9	4	Dutiable property Section 10 (1) (k)
1		substitute
3		(k) an interest in any dutiable property mentioned in paragraphs (a) to (j), except to the extent that—
4		(i) it is, or is attributable to, an option over dutiable property; or
6		(ii) it is an interest under a sublease that—
7		(A) is granted for a term of 30 years or less; and
8		(B) is not a long-term lease.
