## A Bill for

An Act to amend legislation about territory and municipal services

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

3		This Act is the Territory and Municipal Services Legislation Amendment Act 2014.
5	2	Commencement
6		This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

15	(3)	A declaration is a disallowable instrument.
