Domestic Animals (Racing Greyhounds) Amendment Bill 2017

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A Bill for

An Act to amend the *Domestic Animals Act 2000* and the *Domestic Animals Regulation 2001*, and for other purposes

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 **Part 1 Preliminary**

2 **1 Name of Act**

3 This Act is the *Domestic Animals (Racing Greyhounds) Amendment*
4 *Act 2017*.

5 **2 Commencement**

6 This Act commences on 30 April 2018.

7 *Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on
8 the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

9 **3 Legislation amended**

10 This Act amends the *Domestic Animals Act 2000* and the *Domestic*
11 *Animals Regulation 2001*.

12 *Note* This Act also amends the *Animal Welfare Act 1992* and the *Magistrates*
13 *Court (Domestic Animals Infringement Notices) Regulation 2005* (see
14 sch 1).

19 ***greyhound racing*** means 1 or more greyhounds racing in
20 competitive pursuit, and includes—

21 (a) a greyhound trial or training race; and

22 (b) racing in a test of speed of 1 or more racing greyhounds.

23 *Note* A person commits an offence if the person conducts or takes part in
24 greyhound racing in the ACT—see the *Animal Welfare Act 1992*, s 18A.

1 ***racing greyhound*** means a greyhound that is used or intended to be
2 used for greyhound racing.

3 **39B Presumption greyhound is racing greyhound**

- 4 (1) This section applies to a greyhound that is 6 months old or older.
- 5 (2) A greyhound is taken to be a racing greyhound unless the owner of
6 the greyhound gives the registrar a statutory declaration stating that
7 the greyhound is not used, and is not intended to be used, for
8 greyhound racing.

9 *Note 1* If a form is approved under s 147 for this provision, the form must be
10 used.

11 *Note 2* It is an offence to make a false or misleading statement, give false or
12 misleading information or produce a false or misleading document (see
13 [Criminal Code](#), pt 3.4).

14 **39C Racing greyhounds—registration**

- 15 (1) The owner of a racing greyhound may apply to the registrar to
16 register the greyhound as a racing greyhound.

17 *Note 1* If a form is approved under s 147 for this provision, the form must be
18 used.

19 *Note 2* A fee may be determined under s 144 for this provision.

- 20 (2) If the registrar receives an application under subsection (1), the
21 registrar must—

- 22 (a) register the greyhound as a racing greyhound; or
- 23 (b) refuse to register the greyhound as a racing greyhound if the
24 applicant is—
- 25 (i) disqualified from owning or keeping a racing greyhound
26 (in the ACT or elsewhere); or

27 *Note* Section 138A deals with the disqualification of a person
28 from keeping an animal.

1 (ii) disqualified or suspended from participation in
2 greyhound racing under a gaming law or a rule of racing
3 or betting (in the ACT or elsewhere).

4 (3) The registration of a greyhound as a racing greyhound remains in
5 force for 12 months unless sooner surrendered or cancelled.

6 **39D Offence—unregistered racing greyhound**

7 (1) A person must not keep—

8 (a) an unregistered racing greyhound; or

9 (b) a registered racing greyhound if the person is not the registered
10 keeper or licensed racing greyhound controller in relation to
11 the greyhound.

12 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.

13 (2) Subsection (1) does not apply if—

14 (a) the dog is kept by the person for less than 28 days; or

15 (b) the person has been resident in the ACT for less than 28 days.

16 *Note* The defendant has an evidential burden in relation to the matters
17 mentioned in s (2) (see [Criminal Code](#), s 58).

18 (3) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.

19 **39E Racing greyhounds—registration numbers etc**

20 Section 11 (1), (2), (4) and (5) (Registration numbers, certificates
21 and tags) and section 17 (Evidence of registration or
22 non-registration) apply to the registration of a racing greyhound.

- 16 **39G** **Day-to-day control of racing greyhounds—requirement to**

- 18 (1) A person commits an offence if the person—
- 19 (a) has the day-to-day control of a racing greyhound; and
- 20 (b) does not hold a racing greyhound controller licence.
- 21 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.
- 22 (2) A person commits an offence if the person—
- 23 (a) has the day-to-day control of a racing greyhound; and
- 24 (b) holds a racing greyhound controller licence; and

- 1 (c) does not comply with a condition of the licence.
2 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.
- 3 (3) Subsection (1) does not apply to a racing greyhound that is
4 temporarily kept by a veterinary surgeon or at an animal boarding
5 facility.
- 6 (4) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.
- 7 (5) In this section:
- 8 ***animal boarding facility***—
- 9 (a) means a kennel or other premises where animals are kept
10 temporarily by a person other than the registered keeper or the
11 person who has day-to-day control of the animal; and
- 12 (b) includes a facility used for the rescue and rehoming of
13 greyhounds.
- 14 **39H Racing greyhound controller licences—applications**
- 15 (1) A person may apply to the registrar for a licence to be a person in
16 day-to-day control of 1 or more racing greyhounds (a ***racing***
17 ***greyhound controller licence***).
- 18 (2) The application must include—
- 19 (a) the applicant's name and address; and
- 20 (b) the address of the premises where the greyhound or
21 greyhounds are to be kept; and
- 22 (c) if the greyhound or greyhounds are registered with a
23 greyhound racing controlling body—the name of the body.

1 (3) In this section:

2 ***greyhound racing controlling body*** means a body established under
3 a law of a State to conduct greyhound race meetings and greyhound
4 racing within the State.

5 *Note* **State** includes the Northern Territory (see [Legislation Act](#), dict, pt 1).

6 **39I Racing greyhound controller licences—approval or**
7 **refusal**

8 (1) If an application for a racing greyhound controller licence is made
9 under section 39H, the registrar must, by written notice to the
10 applicant—

11 (a) approve the issue of the licence; or

12 (b) refuse to approve the issue of the licence.

13 (2) The registrar must refuse to issue a racing greyhound controller
14 licence unless satisfied that—

15 (a) the yard in which the racing greyhounds will be kept and
16 associated facilities are adequately ventilated and constructed
17 in a way to allow them to be kept in a sanitary condition; and

18 (b) if the application is in relation to 4 or more racing
19 greyhounds—appropriate arrangements exist for the sanitary
20 disposal of waste; and

21 (c) the applicant can otherwise comply with the requirements of
22 the *Animal Welfare Act 1992* and any approved or mandatory
23 code of practice under that Act; and

24 (d) any other requirement prescribed by regulation is met.

- 1 (3) In making a decision under this section, the registrar must consider
2 the following:
- 3 (a) the number of other dogs kept by the applicant;
- 4 (b) the size and nature of the premises where the dogs are to be
5 kept;
- 6 (c) the security of the premises;
- 7 (d) the suitability of facilities for keeping racing greyhounds on
8 the premises;
- 9 (e) the potential impact on the occupiers of neighbouring
10 premises;
- 11 (f) any conviction or finding of guilt of the applicant within the
12 last 10 years against a law of a Territory or State for an offence
13 relating to greyhound racing or the welfare, keeping or control
14 of an animal;
- 15 (g) any disciplinary action taken against the applicant under a
16 gaming law or a rule of racing or betting (in the ACT or
17 elsewhere).
- 18 (4) Subsection (3) does not limit the matters the registrar may consider.

19 **39J Racing greyhound controller licences—conditions**

- 20 (1) A racing greyhound controller licence is subject to—
- 21 (a) the condition that the licensee comply with any relevant
22 mandatory code of practice under the *Animal Welfare*
23 *Act 1992*, section 23 (Mandatory code of practice); and
- 24 (b) any other condition imposed by the registrar when the licence
25 is issued.

- 1 (2) In making a decision whether or not to impose a condition on a
2 racing greyhound controller licence, the registrar must consider the
3 following:
- 4 (a) the number of other dogs kept by the licensee;
- 5 (b) the size and nature of the premises where the dogs are to be
6 kept;
- 7 (c) the potential impact on the occupiers of neighbouring
8 premises.
- 9 (3) The conditions may include the following:
- 10 (a) the confining of each racing greyhound in a yard that will
11 allow the racing greyhound adequate freedom of movement;
- 12 (b) no part of the yard being closer than 2m from a boundary
13 fence;
- 14 (c) there being sufficient shelter for the racing greyhound.
- 15 (4) Subsection (2) does not limit the matters the registrar may consider.

16 **24 Offence—breeding dogs or cats without licence**

- (b) anything else prescribed by regulation.
