An Act to appropriate money for expenditure in relation to the Office of the Legislative Assembly and officers of the Assembly for the financial year beginning on 1 July 2024, and for other purposes

- 2                    This Act is the *Appropriation (Office of the Legislative Assembly)*
- 3                    *Act 2024-2025*.
- 4    **2**        **Commencement**
- 5                    This Act is taken to have commenced on 1 July 2024.
- 6    **3**        **Purposes of Act**
- 7                    This Act is made for the purposes of—
- 8                    (a) the [Self-Government Act](#), section 57 and section 58; and
- 9                    (b) the [Financial Management Act 1996](#), section 6 and section 8.
- 10   **4**        **Meaning of *financial year***
- 11                    In this Act:
- 12                    *financial year* means the year beginning on 1 July 2024.
- 13   **5**        **Terms used in Financial Management Act 1996**
- 14                    A term used in the [Financial Management Act 1996](#) has the same
- 15                    meaning in this Act.
- 16   **6**        **Appropriation of \$4 220 000 for auditor-general**
- 17                    The amount mentioned in table 6, column 1 is appropriated to the
- 18                    auditor-general for net controlled recurrent payments by the
