Residential Tenancies (Posting Termination) Amendment Bill 2025

A Bill for

An Act to amend the Residential Tenancies Act 1997

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1	1		Name of Act
2			This Act is the Residential Tenancies (Posting Termination) Amendment Act 2025.
4	2		Commencement
5			This Act commences on the 7th day after its notification day.
6 7			Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).
8	3		Legislation amended
9			This Act amends the <i>Residential Tenancies Act 1997</i> .
10 11	4		Posting termination clause Schedule 2, section 2.1, clause 102 (1) and (2)
12			substitute
13		(1)	The residential tenancy agreement may be terminated—
14 15 16			(a) if the lessor or the lessor's domestic partner is posted to the ACT in the course of their employment—by the lessor giving the tenant at least 8 weeks notice to vacate the premises; or
17 18 19			(b) if the tenant is posted away from the ACT in the course of their employment—by the tenant giving the lessor at least 8 weeks notice of the tenant's intention to vacate.
20		(2)	A notice under subclause (1) must be accompanied by—
21			(a) evidence of the posting; and
22 23			(b) if the person being posted is the lessor's domestic partner—evidence of the domestic partnership.
24 25 26			Example—evidence of posting a letter from the employer of the person being posted confirming the details of the posting

2		• a declaration made under the Civil Unions Act 2012
3		• a marriage certificate issued under the <i>Marriage Act 1961</i> (Cwlth)

6 7		• a letter from the employer of the person being posted confirming that the employer recognises that person as the lessor's domestic partner

3 4 5	165	Application of posting termination clause to residential tenancy agreement entered into before commencement day
6	(1)	This section applies to a residential tenancy agreement that—
7		(a) was entered into before the commencement day; and
8		(b) contains the posting termination clause.
19 20 21	(2)	The posting termination clause as in force immediately before the commencement day continues to apply to the residential tenancy agreement.
22	(3)	In this section—
23 24		commencement day means the day the Residential Tenancies (Posting Termination) Amendment Act 2025, section 4 commences.
25 26		posting termination clause means the clause in schedule 2, section 2.1.
