A Bill for

An Act to amend the *Liquor Act 2010* and the *Liquor Regulation 2010*, and for other purposes

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

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Part 1 Preliminary

1	Name	of Act

This Act is the *Liquor Amendment Act 2025*.

2 Commencement

- (1) This Act commences on a day fixed by the Minister by written notice.
 - Note 1 The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).
 - Note 2 A single day or time may be fixed, or different days or times may be fixed, for the commencement of different provisions (see Legislation Act, s 77 (1)).
 - Note 3 If a provision (other than a provision mentioned in s (2)) has not commenced within 6 months beginning on the notification day, it automatically commences on the first day after that period (see Legislation Act, s 79).
- (2) If any of the following provisions have not commenced within 18 months beginning on this Act's notification day, they automatically commence on the first day after that period:
 - sections 15 to 20
 - section 35
 - section 38
 - part 3
- schedule 1.
- (3) The Legislation Act, section 79 (Automatic commencement of postponed law) does not apply to a provision mentioned in subsection (2).
