A Bill for

An Act to amend the *Liquor Act 2010* and the *Liquor Regulation 2010*, and for other purposes

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Part 1 Preliminary

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Liquor Amendment Act 2025*.

2 Commencement

(1) This Act commences on a day fixed by the Minister by written notice.

Note 1 The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

Note 2 A single day or time may be fixed, or different days or times may be fixed, for the commencement of different provisions (see [Legislation Act](#), s 77 (1)).

Note 3 If a provision (other than a provision mentioned in s (2)) has not commenced within 6 months beginning on the notification day, it automatically commences on the first day after that period (see [Legislation Act](#), s 79).

(2) If any of the following provisions have not commenced within 18 months beginning on this Act's notification day, they automatically commence on the first day after that period:

- sections 15 to 20
- section 35
- section 38
- part 3
- schedule 1.

(3) The [Legislation Act](#), section 79 (Automatic commencement of postponed law) does not apply to a provision mentioned in subsection (2).

3 Legislation amended

This Act amends the *Liquor Act 2010* and the *Liquor Regulation 2010*.

Note This Act also amends the *Magistrates Court (Liquor Infringement Notices) Regulation 2010* (see sch 1).

14 New part 8A*insert***Part 8A Same-day delivery****143J Meaning of *same-day delivery* etc**

- (1) For this Act, liquor is supplied to a person by *same-day delivery* if it is supplied by delivery—

- (a) to a place in the ACT; and
- (b) on the same day the liquor is bought (whether it was sold in the ACT or elsewhere); and
- (c) under a commercial arrangement (a *delivery order*) made with or facilitated by a same-day delivery provider.

Note The liquor may be supplied to the customer of the delivery order or someone else (see s (3), def *customer*).

- (2) However, liquor is not supplied by *same-day delivery* if it is supplied—

- (a) to a licensee or permit-holder; or
- (b) to a person who may supply the liquor under an exemption in sections 6 to 8A; or
- (c) in circumstances prescribed by regulation.

1 (3) In this Act:

2 *customer*, of a delivery order, means the person who places the
3 delivery order with the same-day delivery provider, whether or not
4 the liquor is supplied to that person.

5 *delivery person* means an individual who delivers liquor supplied by
6 same-day delivery, whether or not the individual is the same-day
7 delivery provider or an employee or agent of the provider.

8 *same-day delivery provider*—

9 (a) means a person who advertises, offers or otherwise indicates to
10 the public that they will supply liquor, or arrange for its supply,
11 by delivery on the same day it is bought; but

12 (b) does not include a delivery person to the extent they deliver
13 liquor under delivery orders taken by another person mentioned
14 in paragraph (a).

15 *take*, a delivery order from a customer, means make, or facilitate the
16 making of, a commercial arrangement with the customer for the
17 supply of liquor by same-day delivery.

2 **Division 8A.2 Sale of liquor supplied by same-day**

4 **143K Same-day delivery provider must give notice of who sells**
5 **liquor supplied by same-day delivery**

- 6 (1) Before a same-day delivery provider starts to take delivery orders for
7 liquor sold by a person (the *seller*), the provider must give the
8 commissioner written notice about the seller.

9 *Note* The seller may be the same-day delivery provider or someone else.

- 10 (2) The notice must—

11 (a) state the name of the seller; and

12 (b) include any other information prescribed by regulation.

- 13 (3) A person commits an offence if—

14 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and

15 (b) the person takes a delivery order for the supply of liquor by
16 same-day delivery; and

17 (c) the person or a delivery person supplies the liquor to someone
18 else under the order; and

19 (d) the person has not given the commissioner written notice about
20 the seller in accordance with this section.

1 **143L Unauthorised sale of liquor supplied by same-day**
2 **delivery**

- 3 (1) A person commits an offence if—
- 4 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
- 5 (b) the person takes a delivery order for the supply of liquor by
- 6 same-day delivery; and
- 7 (c) the person or a delivery person supplies the liquor to someone
- 8 else under the order; and
- 9 (d) the sale of the liquor (whether sold by the same-day delivery
- 10 provider or someone else) was not authorised by a licence.

11 Maximum penalty: 100 penalty units, imprisonment for 12 months

12 or both.

- 13 (2) In this section:

14 *licence* includes a licence (however described) under a law of a State

15 or another Territory regulating the supply of liquor.

16 **Division 8A.3 Same-day delivery restrictions**

17 **143M Daily liquor limit for same-day delivery**

- 18 (1) A person commits an offence if—
- 19 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
- 20 (b) the person takes a delivery order from a customer for the supply
- 21 of liquor by same-day delivery; and
- 22 (c) on a day, the person or a delivery person supplies the liquor to
- 23 the customer or someone else under the order; and

- 1 (d) the amount of liquor supplied exceeds the amount prescribed by
2 regulation, including any other liquor supplied by same-day
3 delivery on that day under delivery orders taken from the
4 customer by the provider.

5 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.

- 6 (2) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.

7 **143N Same-day delivery of liquor must be delayed**

- 8 (1) A person commits an offence if—

- 9 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
10 (b) the person takes a delivery order for the supply of liquor by
11 same-day delivery; and
12 (c) a delivery person supplies the liquor to someone else under the
13 order; and
14 (d) the supply happens before the end of the delayed delivery period
15 for the order.

16 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.

- 17 (2) A person commits an offence if—

- 18 (a) the person is a delivery person; and
19 (b) the person supplies liquor to someone else by same-day delivery
20 under a delivery order; and
21 (c) the supply happens before the end of the delayed delivery period
22 for the order.

23 Maximum penalty:

- 24 (a) if the person is also the same-day delivery provider—50 penalty
25 units; or
26 (b) in any other case—10 penalty units.
27 (3) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.

1 (4) In this section:

2 *delayed delivery period*, for a delivery order, means the period
3 starting at the time the same-day delivery provider takes the order and
4 ending at the time prescribed by regulation.

5 **143O Permitted times for same-day delivery of liquor**

6 (1) A person commits an offence if—

- 7 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
8 (b) the person takes a delivery order for the supply of liquor by
9 same-day delivery; and
10 (c) a delivery person supplies the liquor to someone else under the
11 order; and
12 (d) the supply happens outside the times prescribed by regulation.

13 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.

14 (2) A person commits an offence if—

- 15 (a) the person is a delivery person; and
16 (b) the person supplies liquor to someone else by same-day
17 delivery; and
18 (c) the supply happens outside the times prescribed by regulation.

19 Maximum penalty:

- 20 (a) if the person is also the same-day delivery provider—50 penalty
21 units; or
22 (b) in any other case—10 penalty units.

23 (3) An offence against subsection (2) is a strict liability offence.

2 **public places**
- 3 (1) A person commits an offence if—
4 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
5 (b) the person takes a delivery order for the supply of liquor by
6 same-day delivery; and
7 (c) a delivery person supplies the liquor to someone else under the
8 order; and
9 (d) the place of delivery is a prohibited public place.
10 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.
- 11 (2) A person commits an offence if—
12 (a) the person is a delivery person; and
13 (b) the person supplies liquor to someone else by same-day
14 delivery; and
15 (c) the place of delivery is a prohibited public place.
16 Maximum penalty:
17 (a) if the person is also the same-day delivery provider—50 penalty
18 units; or
19 (b) in any other case—10 penalty units.
- 20 (3) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.
- 21 (4) In this section:
22 ***prohibited public place*** means—

- 10 (1) A person may tell a same-day delivery provider to exclude the person
11 (a *self-excluded person*) from—
12 (a) the supply of liquor by same-day delivery by the provider; and
13 (b) direct advertising and marketing from the provider about the
14 supply of liquor by same-day delivery.
15 (2) A regulation may make further provision in relation to the exclusion
16 of a person under subsection (1).
17 (3) A person commits an offence if—
18 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
19 (b) the person offers to take a delivery order for the supply of liquor
20 by same-day delivery; and
21 (c) the person does not, at the time the offer is made, provide a way,
22 which complies with any requirements prescribed by regulation,
23 for someone to tell the provider they are to be a self-excluded
24 person.

25 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.

- 1 (4) A person commits an offence if—
- 2 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
- 3 (b) the person takes a delivery order from a customer for the supply
- 4 of liquor by same-day delivery; and
- 5 (c) a self-excluded person is—
- 6 (i) the customer; or
- 7 (ii) specified in the delivery order as the person to whom the
- 8 liquor will be delivered.
- 9 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.
- 10 (5) A person commits an offence if—
- 11 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
- 12 (b) the person advertises or markets directly to a self-excluded
- 13 person about the supply of liquor by same-day delivery.
- 14 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.
- 15 (6) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.

16 **Division 8A.4 Responsible service of alcohol by**

17 **same-day delivery**

18 **143R Same-day delivery provider and delivery person must**

19 **have same-day delivery RSA certificate**

- 20 (1) A person commits an offence if—
- 21 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
- 22 (b) the person takes a delivery order for the supply of liquor by
- 23 same-day delivery; and

- 1 (c) the person does not hold a current same-day delivery RSA
2 certificate.

3 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.

- 4 (2) A person commits an offence if—

- 5 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
6 (b) the person takes a delivery order for the supply of liquor by
7 same-day delivery; and
8 (c) a delivery person supplies the liquor to someone else under the
9 order; and
10 (d) the delivery person does not hold a current same-day delivery
11 RSA certificate.

12 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.

- 13 (3) A person commits an offence if—

- 14 (a) the person is a delivery person; and
15 (b) the person supplies liquor to someone else by same-day
16 delivery; and
17 (c) the person does not hold a current same-day delivery RSA
18 certificate.

19 Maximum penalty: 10 penalty units.

- 20 (4) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.

- 21 (5) For this section, a same-day delivery provider that is a corporation
22 ***holds a current same-day delivery RSA certificate*** if each person in
23 the corporation having day-to-day control of delivery operations for
24 the supply of liquor by same-day delivery holds a current same-day
25 delivery RSA certificate.

- 19 (1) A person commits an offence if—
- 20 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
- 21 (b) the person takes a delivery order from a customer for the supply
22 of liquor by same-day delivery; and
- 23 (c) the person has not verified the customer's age in a way that
24 complies with any requirements prescribed by regulation.
- 25 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.
- 26 (2) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.

- 1 **143U Same-day delivery of liquor not permitted to child or**
2 **young person**
- 3 (1) A person commits an offence if—
4 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
5 (b) the person takes a delivery order for the supply of liquor by
6 same-day delivery; and
7 (c) a delivery person supplies the liquor to another person under the
8 order; and
9 (d) the other person is a child or young person.
10 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.
- 11 (2) A person commits an offence if—
12 (a) the person is a delivery person; and
13 (b) the person supplies liquor to another person by same-day
14 delivery; and
15 (c) the other person is a child or young person.
16 Maximum penalty:
17 (a) if the person is also the same-day delivery provider—50 penalty
18 units; or
19 (b) in any other case—10 penalty units.
- 20 (3) An offence against subsection (2) is a strict liability offence.
- 21 (4) This section does not apply in relation to a young person if the young
22 person—
23 (a) was at least 16 years old at the time of the offence; and

- 1 (b) had, at the place of delivery and before the time of the offence,
2 shown a delivery person an identification document identifying
3 the young person as an adult.

4 *Note* The defendant has an evidential burden in relation to the matters
5 mentioned in s (4) (see [Criminal Code](#), s 58).

6 **143V Delivery person may refuse to supply liquor without**
7 **identification document**

8 A delivery person may refuse to supply liquor to a person by
9 same-day delivery if, when asked at the place of delivery, the person
10 does not show the delivery person an identification document
11 identifying the person as an adult.

13 **person**

- 14 (1) A person commits an offence if—
15 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
16 (b) the person takes a delivery order for the supply of liquor by
17 same-day delivery; and
18 (c) a delivery person supplies the liquor to another person under the
19 order; and
20 (d) the other person is intoxicated.

21 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.

- 22 (2) A person commits an offence if—
23 (a) the person is a delivery person; and
24 (b) the person supplies liquor to another person by same-day
25 delivery; and

1 (c) the other person is intoxicated.

2 Maximum penalty:

3 (a) if the person is also the same-day delivery provider—50 penalty
4 units; or

5 (b) in any other case—10 penalty units.

6 (3) An offence against subsection (2) is a strict liability offence.

7 **143X Same-day delivery of liquor must not be left unattended**

8 (1) A person commits an offence if—

9 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and

10 (b) the person takes a delivery order for the supply of liquor by
11 same-day delivery; and

12 (c) a delivery person supplies the liquor to someone else under the
13 order; and

14 (d) the delivery person leaves the liquor unattended at the place of
15 delivery.

16 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.

17 (2) A person commits an offence if—

18 (a) the person is a delivery person; and

19 (b) the person supplies liquor to someone else by same-day
20 delivery; and

21 (c) the person leaves the liquor unattended at the place of delivery.

22 Maximum penalty:

23 (a) if the person is also the same-day delivery provider—50 penalty
24 units; or

25 (b) in any other case—10 penalty units.

26 (3) An offence against subsection (2) is a strict liability offence.

Division 8A.6 Protections for delivery people

143Y Abusive, threatening or intimidating behaviour toward delivery person

(1) A person commits an offence if—

- (a) a delivery person is at a place of delivery under a delivery order; and
- (b) the delivery person, at a place of delivery under a delivery order, refuses to supply liquor by same-day delivery to the person or someone else (the *intended recipient*); and
- (c) the delivery person tells the intended recipient they refuse to supply the liquor because doing so would contravene this Act; and
- (d) the person engages in abusive, threatening or intimidating behaviour towards the delivery person; and
- (e) the behaviour is because of the refusal.

Maximum penalty: 10 penalty units.

(2) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.

143Z Same-day delivery provider must report incidents

(1) This section applies if—

- (a) an incident occurs involving abusive, threatening or intimidating behaviour towards a delivery person at the place of delivery under a delivery order; or
- (b) an incident occurs involving a person refusing to show a delivery person an identification document at the place of delivery under a delivery order; or
- (c) an incident prescribed by regulation occurs in the course of the supply of liquor by same-day delivery under a delivery order.

- 1 (2) The same-day delivery provider who took the delivery order must
2 give the commissioner a written report about the incident within
3 24 hours after it happened.
- 4 (3) The report must include the following details:
- 5 (a) a description of the incident;
- 6 (b) the date and time the incident happened;
- 7 (c) the name, address and contact details of each person involved in
8 the incident, including—
- 9 (i) the same-day delivery provider; and
- 10 (ii) the delivery person;
- 11 (d) any action taken by the provider or a delivery person in relation
12 to the incident;
- 13 (e) if the incident is reported to a police officer—any reference
14 number for the report.
- 15 (4) A person commits an offence if—
- 16 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and
- 17 (b) an incident mentioned in subsection (1) occurs; and
- 18 (c) the person does not give the commissioner a report about the
19 incident in accordance with this section.
- 20 Maximum penalty: 10 penalty units.

21 **143ZA Victimisation of delivery person for refusing to supply**
22 **liquor by same-day delivery**

- 23 (1) A person commits an offence if—
- 24 (a) the person is a same-day delivery provider; and

- 1 (b) a delivery person refuses, or proposes to refuse, to supply liquor
2 by same-day delivery under a delivery order taken by the
3 provider because they reasonably believe that doing so would
4 constitute an offence against this Act; and
- 5 (c) the provider takes, or threatens to take, detrimental action
6 against the delivery person; and
- 7 (d) the provider does so wholly or partially because of the delivery
8 person's refusal or proposed refusal.
- 9 Maximum penalty: 50 penalty units.
- 10 (2) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.
- 11 (3) A regulation may prescribe action that is or is not detrimental action.

12 **Division 8A.7 Miscellaneous**

13 **143ZB Same-day delivery provider must keep records of supply** 14 **and refusal to supply**

- 15 (1) This section applies if a delivery person—
- 16 (a) supplies liquor by same-day delivery under a delivery order; or
- 17 (b) is at the place of delivery under a delivery order but refuses to
18 supply the liquor.
- 19 (2) The same-day delivery provider who took the delivery order must
20 make a record of the supply or refusal.
- 21 (3) The record must—
- 22 (a) include the information prescribed by regulation; and
- 23 (b) be made in a way prescribed by regulation.
- 24 (4) A person commits an offence if—
- 25 (a) the person is required to make a record of the supply or refusal;
26 and

1 (b) the person does not make the record in accordance with this
2 section.

3 Maximum penalty: 20 penalty units.

5 (a) the person makes a record of the supply or refusal; and

6 (b) the person does not keep the record for at least 6 years.
