A Bill for

An Act to appropriate money for expenditure in relation to the Office of the Legislative Assembly and officers of the Assembly for the financial year beginning on 1 July 2026, and for other purposes

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 **1 Name of Act**

2 This Act is the *Appropriation (Office of the Legislative Assembly) Act*
3 2026-2027.

4 **2 Commencement**

5 This Act is taken to have commenced on 1 July 2026.

6 **3 Purposes of Act**

7 This Act is made for the purposes of—

- 8 (a) the Self-Government Act, section 57 and section 58; and
9 (b) the *Financial Management Act 1996*, section 6 and section 8.

10 **4 Meaning of *financial year***

11 In this Act:

12 *financial year* means the year beginning on 1 July 2026.

13 **5 Terms used in Financial Management Act 1996**

14 A term used in the *Financial Management Act 1996* has the same
15 meaning in this Act.

16 **6 Appropriation of \$4 627 000 for auditor-general**

17 The amount mentioned in table 6, column 1 is appropriated to the
18 auditor-general for net controlled recurrent payments by the
19 auditor-general in the financial year.

1 **7 Appropriation of \$5 445 000 for electoral commissioner**

2 (1) The amount mentioned in table 7, column 1 is appropriated to the
