Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991 Approval, and Commencement Date, of Variation No.182 to the Territory Plan – Public Land – Nature Reserve – Yellow Box/Red Gum Grassy Woodland Sites and Aranda Snow Gum Site 2002

Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991, s29 (6) (Consideration of plan variation by Legislative Assembly)

The ACT Executive, pursuant to paragraph 26(1)(a) of the *Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991*, **approved on 19 August 2002 Variation to the Territory Plan No.182 entitled Public Land – Nature Reserve – Yellow Box/Red Gum Grassy Woodland Sites and Aranda Snow Gum Site.**

In accordance with subsection 29(1) of the *Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991*, Plan Variation No.182 was tabled before the Legislative Assembly and had not been disallowed, or deemed to be disallowed, as at 29 August 2002.

Now therefore pursuant to subsection 29(6) of the *Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991*, **I specify that the date of commencement of Variation No.182 to the Territory Plan will be 5 September 2002.**
