
MACHINERY ACT 1949

Issue of a Boiler Attendant's Certificate	
a) issue of boiler attendant's certificate	65.00
b) re-issue of certificate	30.00
Inspection of Boilers	
1) Locomotive, traction engine or road roller boilers, having a heating surface	
a) not exceeding 7.50 square metres	80.00
b) exceeding 7.50 square metres	110.00
2) Boilers (other than locomotive, traction engine or road roller boilers) having a heating surface, including economiser and superheater (if any)	
a) not exceeding 2 square metres	30.00
b) exceeding 2 square metres but not exceeding 5 square metres	50.00
c) Exceeding 5 square metres but not exceeding 15 square metres	80.00
d) exceeding 15 square metres but not exceeding 70 square metres	110.00
e) exceeding 70 square metres but not exceeding 200 square metres	140.00
f) exceeding 400 square metres	180.00 plus 6.00 per 100 square metres or part there of by which the heating surface exceeds 400 square metres

Inspection of Pressure Vessels

- 1) Steam jacketed pan having an internal diameter
 - a) not exceeding 1 metre .25.00
 - b) exceeding 1 metre 30.00
- 2) Other pressure vessels having an internal capacity
 - a) not exceeding 0.055 cubic metres 25.00
 - b) exceeding 0.055 cubic metres but not exceeding 1.5 cubic metres 30.00
 - c) exceeding 1.5 cubic metres but not exceeding 3 cubic metres 50.00
 - d) exceeding 3 cubic metres 70.00

Other

Exempted Vessels

- 1) For an inspection required to be performed on any vessel eligible for exemption, the fee payable shall be 180.00

Single Inspections

- 1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this paragraph, where in one day in any premises an inspection is made of:
 - a) only one boiler and no pressure vessel, or
 - b) only one pressure vessel and no boiler, and the boiler or pressure vessel inspected is one referred to in subparagraph 2(ii)(a), 3(i)(a) and (b), and 3(ii)(a) and (b), the fee to be charged for the inspection shall be 50 percent in excess of the fee otherwise payable

Multiple Inspections

- 1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this paragraph, where in any one day in any premises 5 or more boilers or 5 or more pressure vessels are inspected, the fees to be charged for the inspection shall be 30 percent less than the fees otherwise payable
