KEMSLEY PLACE Sir Alfred Newcombe Kemsley KBE, CMG, CBE (1896-1987)

Armed Serviceman; he enlisted as a private in World War I and rose to the rank of Captain, serving on the Head Quarters staff of Sir John Monash. Soon after the outbreak of World War II he was appointed director of organisation of the Australian Army with rank of Colonel and held other senior posts, including member of the Military Board.
