

HOLT SECTION 98 BLOCK 5

(BELCONNEN GOLF COURSE)

The ACT Planning Authority is inviting comment on a proposed Land Use Policy change for Holt Section 98 Block 5.

It is proposed to change the existing Land Use Policy for the above site to include Residential Use over the central part of the Golf Course site. The existing Land Use Policy for the site is Restricted Access Recreation. It is also proposed to make the whole golf course site 'Defined Land' under the provisions of sections 7(3)(e) and 32 of the Land Act.

In addition, a Preliminary Assessment of potential environmental impacts of this draft Variation to the Territory Plan has been undertaken, as set out in the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991.
