

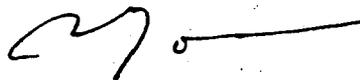
PUBLIC PLACE NAMES ACT 1989

STREET NOMENCLATURE

DIVISION OF GORDON: SPORTSMEN AND WOMEN

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
TRAVERS STREET	Joseph Patrick Francis TRAVERS (1871-1942)	He was a shrewd, slow left-arm bowler. Joe played at Sheffield Shield level. He appeared in the fifth Test at Melbourne against England in 1901/2. This was his sole Test. In 28 Sheffield Shield matches he took 90 wickets.

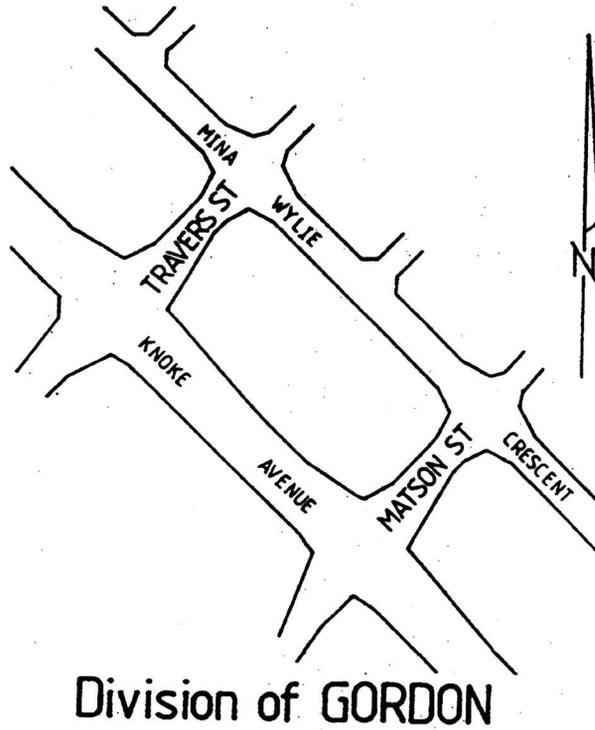
STREET NOMENCLATURE

DIVISION OF GORDON: SPORTSMEN AND WOMEN

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
MATSON STREET	Phillip Henry MATSON (1884-1928)	Sportsman. At the 1905 Australasian Championships in Melbourne he won the 220 yards breast-stroke event. He set a World record of 3 minutes and 14 seconds time for this event in 1908. He turned professional in 1909. He played Australian Rules in Western Australia and South Australia from 1904-1918. He became coach of the East Perth Football Club in 1918. Strengthened by his recruitment of champion players, East perth won seven premierships between 1919 and 1927.
