NATURE CONSERVATION ACT 1980

DETERMINATION OF FEES 1993

DETERMINATION NO. 56 OF 1993

LR 31/5/04

UNDER section 83A of the Nature Conservation Act 1980 I REVOKE the determination of fees number 76, notice of which was published in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No.S99 on 29 June 1992. I DETERMINE that for the purposes of section 63 of the Act, the fee for the grant of a licence shall be as follows:

- 1. to take an animal that is wildlife \$133.00 per annum;
- 2. to sell animals, whether wildlife or not -
 - (a) where the number of animals which may be sold under the licence does not exceed 10 - \$11.00 per annum;
 - (b) where the number of animals which may be sold under the licence exceeds 10 but does not exceed 100 -\$22.50 per annum; and
 - (c) where the number of animals which may be sold under the licence exceeds 100 - \$133.00 per annum;
- to import into, or export from, the Territory for retail purposes an animal, whether wildlife or not - \$22.50 per licence;
- 4. to import into, or export from, the Territory for retail purposes live fish - \$22.50 per annum;
- to sell live fish \$133.00 per annum;

- 6. to pick a plant that is wildlife or to pick restricted plant wildlife -
 - (a) where the number of plants which may be picked under the licence does not exceed 10 \$22.50 per annum; and
 - (b) where the number of plants which may be picked under the licence exceeds 10 - \$133.00 per annum;
- to fell or remove timber \$28.00 per annum;
- 8. to sell a plant that is restricted plant wildlife \$22.50 per annum;
- to grow or cultivate a plant that is restricted plant wildlife for the purposes of sale or trade - \$22.50 per annum;
- 10. to import into, or export from, the Territory for the purposes of sale or trade a plant that is wildlife - \$22.50 per licence;
- 11. to export from the Territory a plant that is restricted plant wildlife, other than a seed or a part of a plant lawfully picked or cultivated - \$22.50 per licence.
