PHARMACY ACT 1931

DETERMINATION OF FEES

NO. 103 OF 1994

Under section 57 of the *Pharmacy Act 1931*

I, Terence Connolly, Minister for Health for the Australian Capital Territory;

1. **REVOKE** all previous determinations of fees payable under subsection 24(d), subsection 25(6), paragraph 26(1)(b), paragraph 26(5)(b), subsection 28(3), subsection 29(1), subsection 30(1), subsection 30(2), subsection 31(2), subsection 31(3), paragraph 48(1)(a) and paragraph 48(1)(b) of the *Pharmacy Act 1931*.
2. **DETERMINE** that the fees for the following provisions in the *Pharmacy Act 1931* as amended by the *Pharmacy (Amendment) Act 1993* shall be in accordance with the schedule.
