### ORIGIN

JAMES BRETT CIRCUIT James Fairlie Brett (1884-1966)

Timber Merchant and Industrialist. Born 19 May 1884 in QLD, at the age of 14 he joined his uncle's timber firm and learned the trade. He established his own business in Blackbutt in 1914. He was a Councillor 1914-20 and Chairman of Nango Shire 1922-24. He was a partner in Brett and Co Pty Ltd which opened in Brisbane in 1923. He began a pattern of constant travel, supervision, organisation and negotiation that would hold together an expanding group of firms, such as Bretts Wharves and Stevendoring Co Ltd in 1928. He was Deputy Chairman of the Primary Producers Bank of Australia Ltd from 1928-31. He formed the joint-venture Yarraman Pine Pty Ltd of which he was founding Chairman from 1932 until 1966. He was Deputy Chairman of the Pine Exports Association from 1933 and the first Chairman of Australian Plywood Board 1939-65 and foundation Chairman of the Old Sawmillers Association 1943-62. He acquired wharves and half a dozen new mills between 1944-49 and was chairman of companies in the family group, and director of wool, gold, oil and several cement companies.

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
CLEGG CLOSE	William Edward Clegg (1886-1957)	Industrialist. In 1901 he was apprenticed as a fitter and turner at A. Gonnian and Co Ltd. In the evening he attended Newcastle Technical College, and later undertook correspondence courses in metallurgy and accounting. He travelled throughout the state for Gonnian's installing winding machines and boilers. In 1916 he established an engineering works at Cowra, NSW. In 1921 he was appointed engineering consultant at Commonwealth Steel Products Co Ltd and became Manager in 1925. When he retired in 1951 he was made Director of Commonwealth Steel. From 1936-55 he was President of the Newcastle Technical Education Advisory Council and from 1951 he represented the university on the Newcastle University College Advisory Committee and was awarded an honorary D.Sc. in 1955. The University of Newcastle has annually awarded the W.E. Clegg memorial prize in mechanical engineering since 1958.

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
HAMBRIDGE STREET	Frank Hambridge (1825-1942)	Born in Glenelg SA. He worked for Henry Scott merchants in Adelaide 1895- 1900. He was Secretary of the Einasleigh Copper Mines Ltd in Brisbane Qld from 1900-03 and Manager of Francis H Snow, Rockhampton 1906-08 and in NSW 1908-15. He was the Managing Director of Refactory Bricks Ltd and Director of Copper Exploration Co Ltd from 1911-15.
GARTRELL CLOSE	James Gartrell (1846-1925)	Born in Cornwell, England. He arrived in Australia with his parents in 1849. He worked for Gilbert Wood (founder of G. Wood and Son Co wholesale grocers and importers) and became a partner in 1866 and Chairman in 1876. He formed the Wholesale Grocers Association and Wholesale Hardware Merchants Association and became President of the Chamber of Commerce in 1900.
