b. Reservation Fees

A Certificate of Reservation can be purchased entitling the Certificate Holder to an Exclusive Right of Burial at some time during the next 25 years. At the time of purchase the Certificate, the relevant Allotment Fee and Maintenance Fee must be pre-paid. At the first, or subsequent interments a Maintenance Fee is payable to extend the maintenance period to a full 50 years after the last interment.

Reservation of an un-specified allotment, or the adjacent allotment at the time of a burial (limit of one allotment):

No Premium Fee.

Reservation of a Specific Allotment in an established part of Cemetery:

Premium Fee = 50% of relevant allotment fee.

Exclusive Right of Burial and Certificates of Reservation are renewable but will lapse if not renewed prior to the expiration of tenure

Coffin/Casket Sizes

- a. Regular size coffin or casket 2130 mm x 710 mm or less.
- b Any coffin or casket which exceeds 2130 mm x 710 mm is classified as oversize.

Double Allotments

- a. <u>Headstone Areas</u> Double monuments may only be constructed on double allotments, and accordingly double permit fees apply For the purpose of tenure, a double allotment is a single entity.
- b. <u>Family Estate</u>. Only double allotments are available in Family Estate areas. Single or double memorials may be constructed subject to the payment of the relevant fee. For the purpose of tenure, double allotment is a single entity
