### Class 1

An operator other than a person who is exempt under section 13 (2) of the Act who performs a skin penetration procedure for a fee, reward or other consideration.

- An operator who is also the proprietor of a skin penetration procedures business,
- Student practitioner who is under the direct supervision of a registered health care provider or a licensed operator.
