

**COURSES AND AWARDS AMENDMENT STATUTE 1996**

**Citation and interpretation**

1. This Statute may be cited as the *Courses and Awards Amendment Statute 1996*.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Statute:  
*Principal Statute* means the *Courses and Awards Statute 1995*.

**Amendment of section 3 of the Principal Statute**

3. Section 3 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:
  - (a) before "Master of Applied Science", insert "Master of Advertising and Public Relations";
  - (b) after "Master of Information Technology", insert "Master of International Business";
  - (c) after "Master of Legal Studies", insert "Master of Marketing Communication";
  - (d) after "Master of Sports Medicine", insert "Master of Sports Physiotherapy";
  - (e) after "Doctor of Business Administration", insert "Doctor of Education".

**Amendment of section 4 of the Principal Statute**

4. (1) Section 4 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:
  - (a) after "Graduate Diploma in Court and Parliamentary Reporting", insert "Graduate Diploma in Critical Care Nursing";
  - (b) after "Graduate Diploma in Environmental Education", insert "Graduate Diploma in Gerontic Nursing";
  - (c) after "Graduate Diploma in Information Systems", insert "Graduate Diploma in International Business";
  - (d) after "Graduate Diploma in Media", insert "Graduate Diploma in Mental Health Nursing Graduate Diploma in Midwifery";

- (e) after "Graduate Diploma in Office Management", insert "Graduate Diploma in Oncology Nursing";
- (f) after "Graduate Diploma in Recreational Planning", insert "Graduate Diploma in Rehabilitation Nursing".

**Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Statute**

5. Section 5 of the Principal Statute is amended by inserting after "Graduate Certificate of Management Studies", "Graduate Certificate in Records and Archives Management".
