MOTOR TRAFFIC ACT 1936

DETERMINATION No. 274 OF 1997

CLASS B CLASSES OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Under subsection 149 (1) of the *Motor Traffic Act 1936*, I revoke the determination of 7 November 1996 relating to Class B classes of motor vehicles

I determine that a class of motor vehicles listed in the Schedule is a Class B class of motor vehicles

This determination commences on the same day as paragraph 4 (c) of the *Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act (No 4) 1997* commences

SCHEDULE

CLASS B CLASSES OF MOTOR VEHICLES

- 1 A motor vehicle used for the conveyance of a disabled person,
- 2 A motor vehicle used by a medical practitioner in the course of her or his duties as a medical practitioner,
- 3 A motor vehicle used by a community nurse in the course of her or his duties as a community nurse,
- 4 A motor vehicles used by a volunteer authorised by a community organisation, while in use for the purposes of the community organisation,
- 5 A motor vehicle used by a member of the Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory while fulfilling her or his duties as a member,
- 6 A motor vehicle used by a person authorised by the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory,
- 7 A motor vehicle used by a Senator or a member of the House of Representatives while that Senator or member of the House of Representatives is fulfilling her or his duties as a member of Parliament,
- 8 A motor vehicle used by a resident of an area zoned for residents-only parking,
- 9 A motor vehicle used by a holder of a current ACTION "park and ride" bus pass or ticket,
- 10 A motor vehicle used by the Commonwealth or a Commonwealth authority, while in use for the purposes of the Commonwealth or that Commonwealth authority, and
- 11 A motor vehicle used by the Australian Capital Territory (ACT) or an ACT authority, while in use for the purposes of the ACT or that ACT authority

For the purposes of this determination

"ACT authority" means a body, whether incorporated or not, established by a law of the Australian Capital Territory, but does not include a Territory owned corporation,

"Commonwealth authority" has the same meaning as in the *Commonwealth Vehicles (Registration and Exemption from Taxation) Act 1997* of the Commonwealth,

“community nurse” means a person employed by ACT Community Care as a community nurse,

“community organisation” has the same meaning as in the *Motor Traffic Act 1936*,

“disabled person” means

- (a) a person who has an impaired ability to walk due to a physical disability, or
- (b) a person who is legally blind,

“medical practitioner” means a medical practitioner registered under the *Medical Practitioners Registration Act 1930* or who is deemed to be registered under that Act by virtue of the *Mutual Recognition Act 1992* of the Commonwealth, and

“Territory owned corporation” has the same meaning as in the *Territory Owned Corporations Act 1990*
