i) for any number of sheep the property of one person and impounded at the same time, not exceeding 100	7.15 plus 2.15 per kilometre or part of a kilometre after the first kilometre



 <u>Sustenance fees in respect of (Section 11(1A)):</u>	
(a) each sheep or goat	1.90 per day
(b) any other animal	9.60 per day
 <u>Inspection of Books:</u>	
(a) in the case of a request to inspect the pound book for any period not earlier than 6 months preceding the date of the request, or to inspect the Act and Regulations (Section 16(3))	4.50 for each period of 10 minutes or part of 10 minutes that the book is inspected, with a minimum fee of 6.20
(b) in the case of a request to inspect the pound book for any period earlier than 6 months preceding the date of the request (Section 16(3))	6.20 for each period of 10 minutes or part of 10 minutes that the book is inspected.
