
### **STREET NOMENCLATURE**

#### **Division of Nicholls: Australian Sports Men & Women**

<b>NAME</b>	<b>ORIGIN</b>	<b>SIGNIFICANCE</b>
Whitfield Circuit	Whitfield, Beverley (1954-1996)	One of Australia's greatest swimmers, three gold medals at 1970 Commonwealth Games in Edinburgh, Olympic Gold in 200m breaststroke at Munich 1972.
Lindwall Place	Lindwall, Raymond Russell (Ray) (1921-1996)	Pace bowler, took 228 test wickets over 14 years of international cricket, spearhead of Australia's pace attack until the mid-1950s.
Hoad Place	Hoad, Lewis (1934-1994)	One of Australia's greatest tennis players winning numerous titles including: Davis Cup 1953, Wimbledon, French and Australian singles titles 1956.
