COURSES AND AWARDS AMENDMENT STATUTE 1997

Citation

1. This Statute may be cited as the *Courses and Awards Amendment Statute 1997*.

Interpretation

2. In this Statute:

Principal Statute means the *Courses and Awards Statute 1995*.

Amendment of section 3 of the Principal Statute

3. Section 3 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:
 - (a) after "Bachelor of Applied Economics", insert
"Bachelor of Applied Psychology
Bachelor of Applied Psychology (Honours)";
 - (b) after "Bachelor of Arts in Tourism", insert "Bachelor of Business
Administration";
 - (c) after "Bachelor of Commerce in Management Sciences", insert
"Bachelor of Communication
Bachelor of Communication (Honours)
Bachelor of Community Education";
 - (d) after "Bachelor of Industrial Design", insert
"Bachelor of Information Management
Bachelor of Information Management (Honours)";
 - (e) after "Bachelor of Laws", insert "Bachelor of Management";
 - (f) omit "Bachelor of Nursing", substitute
"Bachelor of Nursing
Bachelor of Nursing (Honours)
Bachelor of Science
Bachelor of Social Science
Bachelor of Tourism";
 - (g) after "Master of Corporate Law", insert "Master of Defence Studies";
 - (h) after "Master of Environmental Education", insert "Master of Human
Resource Management";

- (1) omit "Master of Urban and Regional Planning", substitute:
"Master of Urban and Regional Planning
Master of Urban Management".

Amendment of section 4 of the Principal Statute

4. Section 4 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:
- (a) after "Graduate Diploma in Community Counselling", insert "Graduate Diploma in Computing";
 - (b) after "Graduate Diploma in Policy Studies", insert "Graduate Diploma in Professional Accountancy";
 - (c) after "Graduate Diploma in Urban and Regional Planning", insert "Graduate Diploma in Urban Management".


Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Statute

5. Section 5 of the Principal Statute is amended by inserting "Graduate Certificate in Accountancy" before "Graduate Certificate in Community Counselling".
