INSTRUMENT NO. 234 OF 1999

DRIVERS' LICENCES

Under section 217A of the *Motor Traffic Act 1936* (the Act) I revoke Determination No. 223 of 1999 dated 11 June 1999 and notified in the Gazette No. 37 of 15 September 1999, and I determine that:

(a) the fee payable in respect of the sections of the Act specified in the Schedule shall be the fee specified in the Schedule for that section; and

(b) the fee payable for the purposes of Regulation 22 of the Motor Traffic Regulations made under the Act shall be the fee specified in the Schedule for that Regulation.

This instrument commences operation on 1 October 1999.
