**COURSES AND AWARDS AMENDMENT STATUTE (No. 2) 1999**

**Citation**

1. This Statute is the *Courses and Awards Amendment Statute (No. 2) 1999*.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Statute:

*Principal Statute* means the *Courses and Awards Statute 1995*.

**Amendment of section 3 of the Principal Statute**

3. Section 3 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

- (a) after “Bachelor of Engineering in Manufacturing Systems Engineering”,  
insert “Bachelor of Engineering in Software Engineering”;
- (b) after “Bachelor of Social Science”,  
insert “Bachelor of Software Engineering”;
- (c) after “Master of Arts in Community Education”,  
insert “Master of Arts in English Language Teaching”;
- (d) after “Master of Arts in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages”,  
insert “Master of Arts in Technology Enhanced Language Learning”;
- (e) omit “Master of Education  
Master of Education in Counselling  
Master of Education in School Counselling”,  
insert “Master of Design  
Master of Education  
Master of Education (Honours)  
Master of Education in Counselling  
Master of Education in Health Promotion

Master of Education in School Counselling  
Master of Educational Leadership”;

- (f) after “Master of Environmental Education”,  
insert “Master of Human Resource Development”.

**Amendment of section 4 of the Principal Statute**

4. Section 4 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

- (a) after “Graduate Diploma in Curriculum”,  
insert “Graduate Diploma in Design and Technology”;
- (b) after “Graduate Diploma in Gerontic Nursing”,  
insert “Graduate Diploma in Health Promotion  
Graduate Diploma in Higher Education”;
- (c) after “Graduate Diploma in Marketing”,  
insert “Graduate Diploma in Marketing Communication”;
- (d) after Graduate Diploma in Professional Communication”,  
insert “Graduate Diploma in Professional Development Education”;
- (e) after “Diploma in Technological Sciences”,  
insert “Graduate Diploma in Technology Enhanced Language Learning”.

**Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Statute**

5. Section 5 of the Principal Statute is amended by omitting all words after “awarded by the University:” and inserting:

“Graduate Certificate in Accountancy  
Graduate Certificate in Business  
Graduate Certificate in Business Administration  
Graduate Certificate in Cancer Nursing  
Graduate Certificate in Community Counselling  
Graduate Certificate in Design
