
STREET NOMENCLATURE

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Van Praag Circuit	Lionel Van Praag (1908 – 1987)	Lionel Van Praag was the first Australian motor cyclist to win an official World Speedway Championship in it's inaugural year, 1936, and also reaching the final in 1937, 1938 and 1939. He was a RAAF pilot in WW2 and was awarded the George Medal for heroic action when his plane was shot down in 1941. He resumed racing after the war but retired in 1950.
Sawicki Street	Elizabeth Sawicki (1950 – 1997)	She had many successes as a tournament bridge player, including the 1997 Victorian Open Pairs. She was selected in the Australian Team for the 1997 Maccabiah Games in Israel, but died from medical complications following the bridge collapse during the Opening Ceremony.
