

Division of Russell: Armed services personnel

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Sellheim Avenue	Major General Victor Conradsdorf Morisset Sellheim (1866-1928)	Soldier and Licensed Surveyor. An Army administrator who saw action in South Africa, was administrative head of the AIF in Middle East during WW1 and later in charge of AIF Administrative Headquarters based in England. Resigned from Army in 1927 to become Administrator of Norfolk Island.
