COURSES AND AWARDS AMENDMENT STATUTE 2000

Citation

1. This Statute may be cited as the *Courses and Awards Amendment Statute 2000*.

Interpretation

2. In this Statute:

Principal Statute means the *Courses and Awards Statute 1995*.

Amendment of section 3 of the Principal Statute

3. Section 3 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

- (a) after “Bachelor of Graphic Design”,
insert “Bachelor of Hotel Management”;
- (b) after “Master of Environmental Education”,
insert “Master of Facilities Management”;
- (c) after “Doctor of Environmental Design”,
insert “Doctor of Information Technology”.

Amendment of section 4 of the Principal Statute

4. Section 4 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

- (a) after “Graduate Diploma in Business Administration”,
insert “Graduate Diploma in Clinical Trials Management”;
- (b) omit “Graduate Diploma in Environmental Education”,
insert “Graduate Diploma in Environmental Education
Graduate Diploma in Facilities Management
Graduate Diploma in Financial Planning”.

Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Statute

5. Section 5 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

- (a) after “Graduate Certificate in Cancer Nursing”,
insert “Graduate Certificate in Clinical Trials Management”;
- (b) omit “Graduate Certificate in Environmental Education”,
insert “Graduate Certificate in Environmental Education
Graduate Certificate in Facilities Management
Graduate Certificate in Financial Planning”;

- (c) after “Graduate Certificate in Technology Enhanced Language Learning”,
insert “Graduate Certificate of Applied Science”.
