#### STREET NOMENCLATURE



NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Kelleway Avenue	Charles Kelleway (1889-1944)	Batsman and skilled bowler; played 26 Test matches between 1912-1929 and 39 Sheffield Shield matches; made 6,389 runs including 15 centuries, and took 339 wickets during his first-class career, 1907-28.
