MENTAL HEALTH (TREATMENT AND CARE) ACT 1994

INSTRUMENT NO. 364 of 2000

Under subsection 5(1) of the *Administration Act 1989*, I hereby **REVOKE** all previous delegations of my powers and functions under section 119 of the *Mental Health (Treatment and Care) Act 1994*.

Under subsection 5(1) of the *Administration Act 1989*, I hereby **DELEGATE** my powers and functions under section 119 of the *Mental Health (Treatment and Care) Act 1994* to the person holding, occupying or performing the duties of the office specified in Column 3 of the Schedule. The specific powers and functions delegated and limitations imposed are set out in Column 2 and 4 of the Schedule respectively.
