ROAD TRANSPORT (GENERAL) ACT 1999

DECLARATION THAT PART 10 OF THE ROAD TRANSPORT (GENERAL) ACT 1999 DOES NOT APPLY TO CERTAIN PERSONS AND VEHICLES

INSTRUMENT NO. 378 OF 2000

Pursuant to paragraph 13(1) of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* ('the Act'), I declare that Part 10 of the Act and the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Regulations 2000* do not apply to:

- an unregistered motor vehicle or the owner or user of such a motor vehicle;
 - an Entrant motor vehicle or the owner or any user of such a motor vehicle;
 - an Entrant/Camper motor vehicle or the owner or any user of such a motor vehicle;
 - a Support motor vehicle or the owner or any user of such a motor vehicle; and
 - a Promotional motor vehicle or the owner or any user of such a motor vehicle,
- while the vehicles are within the fenced area of Exhibition Park In Canberra, as highlighted in the attached map, and used in the event known as the Summernats 14 – Car Festival.

This declaration has effect from noon on 3 January 2001 until 10 am on 8 January 2001 inclusive.

For this declaration:

- 'used' includes drive, park or stop the vehicle on a road or road related area within the fenced area of Exhibition Park In Canberra, as highlighted in the attached map;
- 'Entrant motor vehicle' means a motor vehicle that has been issued with a colour coded windscreen sticker containing a unique identification number;
- 'Entrant/Camper motor vehicle' means a motor vehicle that has been issued with a colour coded windscreen sticker containing a unique identification number and bearing the words 'Entrant Camper';

- 'Support motor vehicle' means a motor vehicle that has been issued with a colour coded windscreen sticker containing a unique identification number and bearing the words 'Support Vehicle – On Site Parking' or 'Support Vehicle – Off Site Parking'; and
- 'Promotional motor vehicle' means a motor vehicle that has been issued with a windscreen sticker containing a unique identification number.
