#### Abstract

Under section 96 of the Road Transport (General) Act 1999 (the Act), I determine that the fee payable in respect of the provisions of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000 (the Regulations), made under the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Act 1999, specified in the attached Schedule shall be the fee specified in the Schedule for that provision.


This Determination commences on the commencement of the Road Transport (General) Act 1999.
