INSTRUMENT NO. 9 OF 2000

DELEGATION OF POWERS

In accordance with the provisions of section 5(1) of the *Administration Act 1989* (the Act) I, Garry Humphries, Acting Minister for Health and Community Care, hereby delegate the those powers set out in the left hand column of the Schedule for the purposes specified in the right hand column of the Schedule to the person holding, or for the time being occupying, the position of Director of Environmental Health, Health Protection Service of the Australian Capital Territory Department of Health and Community Care.

Section 29(1) of the <i>Public Health Act 1997</i> Activity licence - application	The power to receive public health risk activity licence applications.
Section 29(2)(a) of the <i>Public Health Act 1997</i> Activity licence - application	The power to approve public health risk activity licence application forms.
Section 30(1) of the <i>Public Health Act 1997</i> Activity licence - grant or refusal.	The power to grant or refuse to grant public health risk activity licences.
Section 31(a) of the <i>Public Health Act 1997</i> Activity licence – form.	The power to approve the public health risk activity licence form.
Section 33(1) of the <i>Public Health Act 1997</i> Activity licence - renewal.	The power to renew an existing public health risk activity licence.
Section 34(1) of the <i>Public Health Act 1997</i> Activity licence – variation.	The power to vary an existing public health risk activity licence at the request of the licence holder.
Section 34(2) of the <i>Public Health Act 1997</i> Activity licence – variation.	The power to issue a notice of intention to vary a public health risk activity licence.
Section 34(3) of the <i>Public Health Act 1997</i> Activity licence – variation.	The power to vary a public health risk activity licence in the interests of public health.
Section 34(4) of the <i>Public Health Act 1997</i> Activity licence – variation.	The power not to vary a public health risk activity licence in the interests of public health.
Section 37(1) of the <i>Public Health Act 1997</i> Activity licence – grant or refusal of transfer.	The power to grant or refuse to grant a transfer of an existing public health risk activity licence.

Section 40(2) of the *Public Health Act 1997*
Activity licence – emergency suspension.

The power to suspend a public health
risk activity licence in the event of an
emergency connected with the licence.
