REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES

INSTRUMENT No. 143 OF 2001

1. Pursuant to section 83A of the *Nature Conservation Act 1980* (the Act) I **REVOKE** the Determination No 171 of 2000 notified in Gazette No S20 of 8 June 2000 and I **DETERMINE** that the fees payable for the purposes of the Act shall be in accordance with the Schedule.
