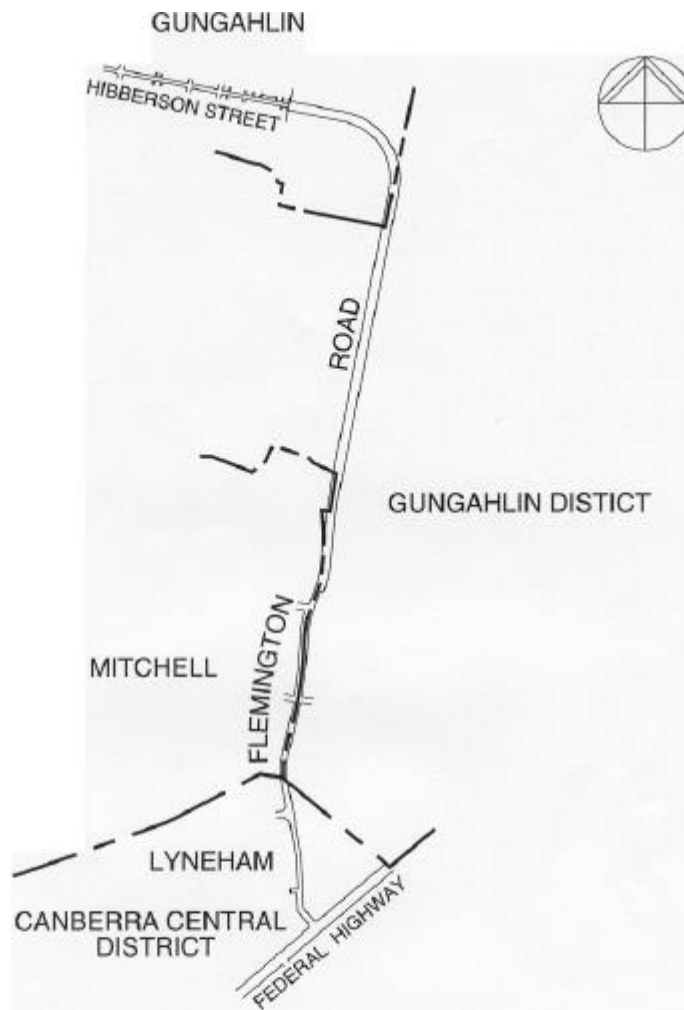

Flemington Road	Division of Lyneham, Mitchell, Gungahlin and the District of Gungahlin.	<p>Flemington Race Course – Racecourse where the famous Melbourne Cup is run.</p> <p>Flemington Racecourse's name originated from the property name on which this racecourse stands. Robert and Janet Fleming owned the land and their property became known as Fleming Town.</p> <p>Robert Fleming granted permission to Melbourne's racing administrators to conduct meetings on his land and a bracelet made with gold from Bendigo was presented to his wife to celebrate the first meeting held there.</p>
