ROAD TRANSPORT (VEHICLE REGISTRATION) REGULATIONS 2000

DECLARATION OF KINDS OF VEHICLE TO BE SEASONAL VEHICLES

INSTRUMENT NO. 30 OF 2001

Pursuant to subregulation 31(4) of the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000* and section 5 of the Subordinate Laws Act 1989, I declare the following kinds of vehicles to be seasonal vehicles:

- vehicles used in primary production;
- heavy vehicles;
- motorcycles; and
- caravans.

For this declaration, the following definitions apply:

vehicle used in primary production means a primary producer's goods vehicle or a primary producer's tractor, as defined in Schedule 1 to the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Regulations 2000*.

heavy vehicle has the same meaning as in the dictionary to the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Act 1999*.

motorcycle means a motorbike or motortrike, as defined in the dictionary to the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000*.

caravan means an enclosed trailer constructed to be used as mobile living quarters, working quarters or for food vending.
