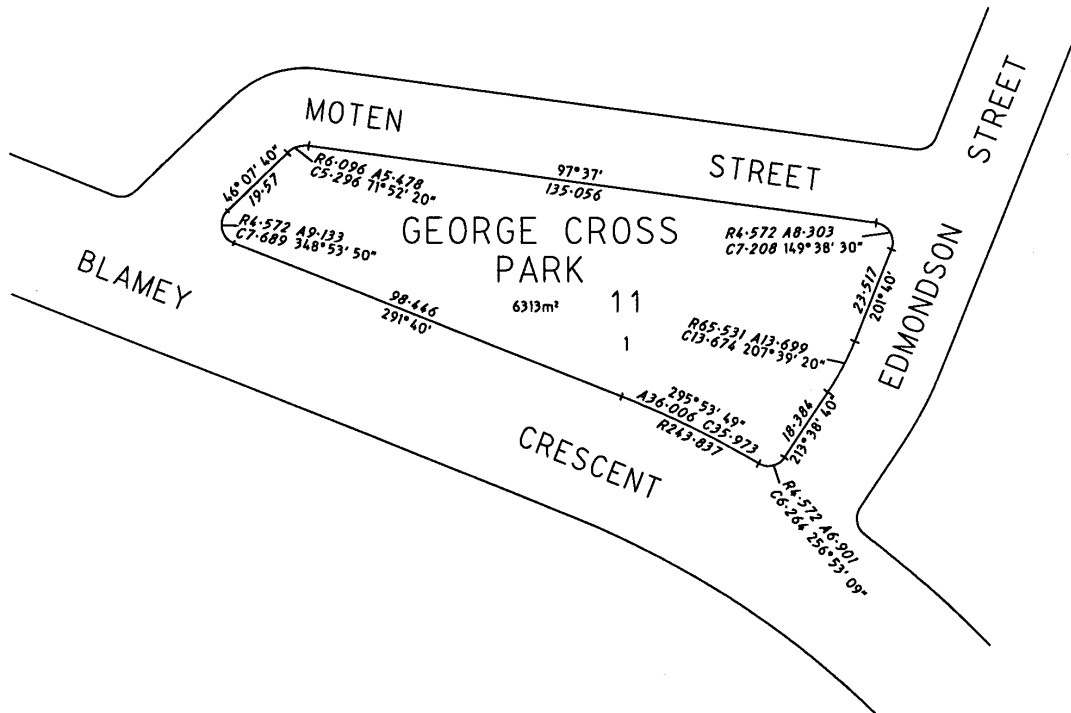



<b>NAME</b>	<b>ORIGIN</b>	<b>SIGNIFICANCE</b>
George Cross Park	The George Cross Award	<p>A year after the outbreak of World War 2, His Majesty King George VI announced the creation of a new award for bravery, aimed at recognising the valour of civilians and service personnel. The George Cross was instituted on 23 September 1940 but the instrument of appointment was re-issued on 8 May 1941.</p> <p>The George Cross is awarded for “acts of the greatest heroism or of the most conspicuous courage in circumstances of extreme danger.”</p> <p>The award is intended for civilians but a Military Division does exist and several Australian servicemen won the George Cross, especially for bomb and mine disposal, during World War 2.</p>
