## Disallowable Instrument DI 2002 — 130

made under the

*Workers' Compensation ACT 1951, Section 28 – Determination of fees*

1. I **REVOKE** the Determination No 132 of 2001 dated 12 June 2001 notified in the Special Gazette No S34 of 20 June 2001 and I **DETERMINE** that the fees for the purposes of the Act shall be in accordance with the Schedule.
2. The fees for services provided are specified in the Schedule hereunder in Column 2 and prices for 2002-2003 are specified in Column 4 opposite, in relation to that service. Where applicable, GST inclusive fees are marked with a double asterisk (\*\*).

Headings and explanatory notes in the Schedule do not form part of the determination.
