Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Guidelines 2002

Disallowable instrument DI2002— 28

made under the

Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulations 2000, section no 75B (1)
(Parking Authority Guidelines)

1. All signs and road markings used by the Parking Authority must be consistent with the relevant Australian Standard and the Australian Road Rules.
2. The Parking Authority must advise the Road Transport Authority in writing of the parking fees to be charged by the Parking Authority, and any changes to these fees.
3. The Parking Authority must clearly identify the parking area as a pay parking area.
4. The fees must be clearly displayed at each ticket machine within the ticket parking area.
5. If enforcement of the ticket parking area is required, the organisation must write to the Road Transport Authority requesting enforcement by authorised persons.
6. Enforcement of Road Transport Authority parking permits is to be consistent with practices in ACT Government car parks.
7. A plan showing the traffic control devices in the ticket parking area must be submitted to the Authority, and the Authority be advised of any changes to the ticket parking area.
8. The Parking Authority must notify the enforcing agency (ACT Parking Operations) of any ticket machine malfunctions immediately so appropriate enforcement arrangements can be made.
9. An example of the parking ticket is to be submitted to the Road Transport Authority to ensure compliance with regulations 80 and 81 of the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulations 2000.
