Citation

1. This Statute may be cited as the *Courses and Awards Amendment Statute 2002*.

Interpretation

2. In this Statute:

Principal Statute means the *Courses and Awards Statute 1995*.

Amendment of section 3 of the Principal Statute

3. Section 3 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

- (a) after “Bachelor of Business Administration”,
insert “Bachelor of Commerce (Honours)”;
- (b) after “Bachelor of Information Technology and English”,
insert “Bachelor of Interior Design”;
- (c) after “Bachelor of Management”,
insert “Bachelor of Medical Science”;
- (d) after “Master of Counselling Psychology”,
insert “Master of Customs Management”;
- (e) after “Master of Education (Honours)”,
insert “Master of Education in Community Health Promotion”;
- (f) omit “Doctor of Business Administration”,
insert “Doctor of Applied Psychology
Doctor of Business Administration”.

Amendment of section 4 of the Principal Statute

4. Section 4 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

- (a) after “Graduate Diploma in Community Counselling”,
insert “Graduate Diploma in Community Health Promotion”;
- (b) after “Graduate Diploma in Curriculum”,
insert “Graduate Diploma in Customs Management”;
- (c) after “Graduate Diploma in Environmental Education”,
insert “Graduate Diploma in Environmental Statistics”;
- (d) after “Graduate Diploma in Nursing”,
insert “Graduate Diploma in Nutrition and Marketing”.

Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Statute

5. Section 5 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

- (a) omit “Graduate Certificate in Community Counselling”.

- insert “Graduate Certificate in Community Counselling
Graduate Certificate in Community Health Promotion
Graduate Certificate in Customs Management”;
- (b) after “Graduate Certificate in Gerontological Nursing”,
insert “Graduate Certificate in Good Clinical Practice”;
- (c) after “Graduate Certificate in Photonic Engineering”,
insert “Graduate Certificate in Physics Teaching”.
