Section 144 Refunds - The registrar has the ability to refund fees, in part, in relation to the Permit to Keep an Animal Sexually Entire should certain criteria be met in respect to the applicants request for such of Permit being of Permit being consideration. Consideration will be given to circumstances where:

- owners relocate interstate;
- the animal has been desexed within three years; or
- animal dies within three years of the owner applying for the Permit.

The registrar has the discretion to refund fees paid in relation to the sale of a dog from the pound.
