Commissioner for the Environment Act, section no 4 (1)

I determine that the current appointment of JOSEPH THOMAS BAKER as Commissioner for the Environment is extended until 31 December 2003 on the following terms and conditions:

- (a) The Commissioner may engage in activities, whether for remuneration or otherwise, apart from the activities relating to his functions and powers under the Act, but before engaging in any other activity in respect of which the Commissioner acquires an interest, pecuniary or otherwise, that could conflict with the proper performance of the Commissioner's functions under the Act, the Commissioner must, in writing, disclose the interest to the Minister and must not engage in any other activity unless the Minister consents in writing.
