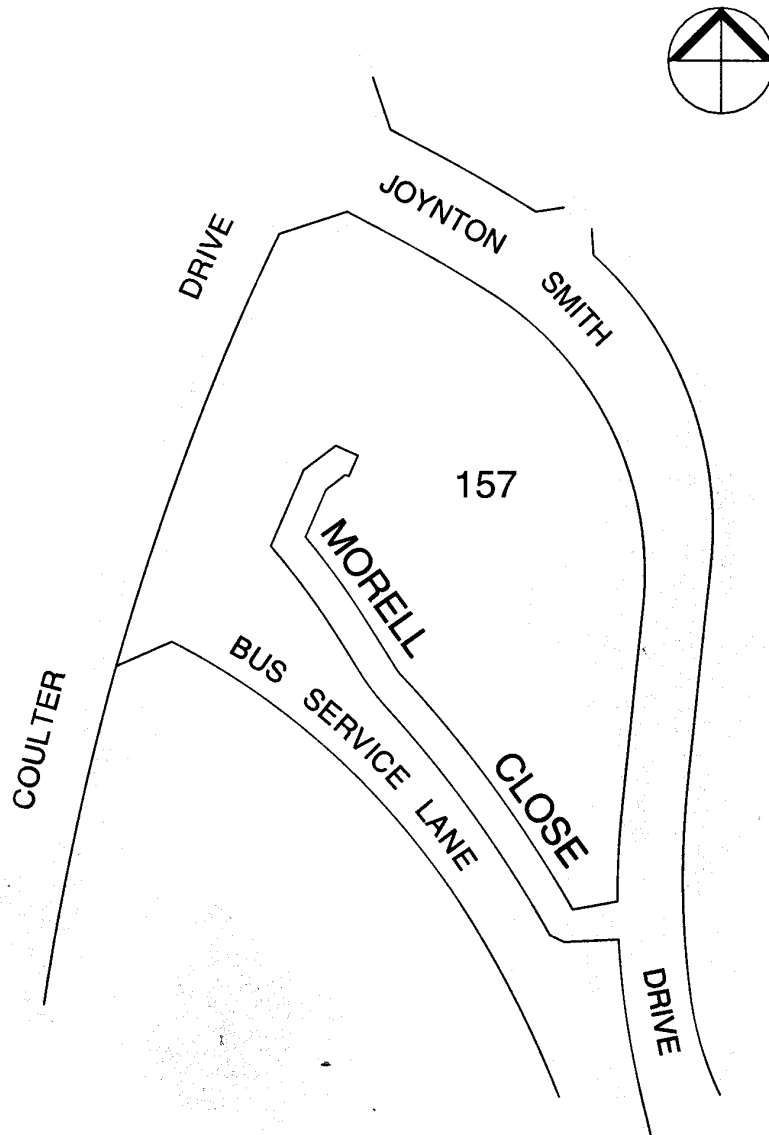

| Morell Close | Sir Stephen Joseph Morell (1869-1944) | <p>Lord Mayor</p> <p>Stephen Joseph Morell was born in Melbourne, Victoria.</p> <p>Sir Joseph was a member of the Melbourne City Council for 38 years from 1901. He became an Alderman in 1925 and was Lord Mayor of Melbourne for two terms 1926-27 & 1927-28.</p> <p>He had many interests; was the President of the Mercantile Rowing Club for 28 years and also the founder of the Metropolitan Football Association.</p> <p>Sir Joseph received a Knight Bachelor on 8 July 1927.</p> |
