1 Name of instrument

4 Definitions

For this declaration, the following definitions apply:

Competing vehicle means:

Any vehicle used for participating in a 'green' special stage of the Light Car Club of Canberra Jerrabomberra Club Hotel Rallysprint 2004.

'Green' special stage means:

The period from the time when a special stage is declared to be active for rally competition until the time when course control for that special stage is declared closed.

Special stage means:

The competitive routes for the following special stages shown on the attached map, described as:

- Special stage 1 (SS1) Smurf's Peak 1;
- Special stage 2 (SS2) The Teabag 1;
- Special stage 3 (SS3) Smurf's Peak 2;
- Special stage 4 (SS4) The Teabag 2;
- Special stage 5 (SS5) Smurf's Peak 3; and
- Special stage 6 (SS6) The Teabag 3.
