made under the

Domestic Animals Act 2000, section 81(1) (Declaration of cat curfew)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Domestic Animals (Cat Curfew Area) Declaration 2004 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after the last day when it could have been disallowed.

3 Determination

Pursuant to section 81(1) of the *Domestic Animals Act 2000* (the Act), I determine that Bonner, Forde, Mulligans Flat, and Goorooyarroo (the Declared Cat Curfew Area), as defined in the Territory Plan and as set out in the attached Schedule, is to be a cat curfew area where cats must be confined to their keepers or carer's premises for 24 hours a day for the purpose of the Act.

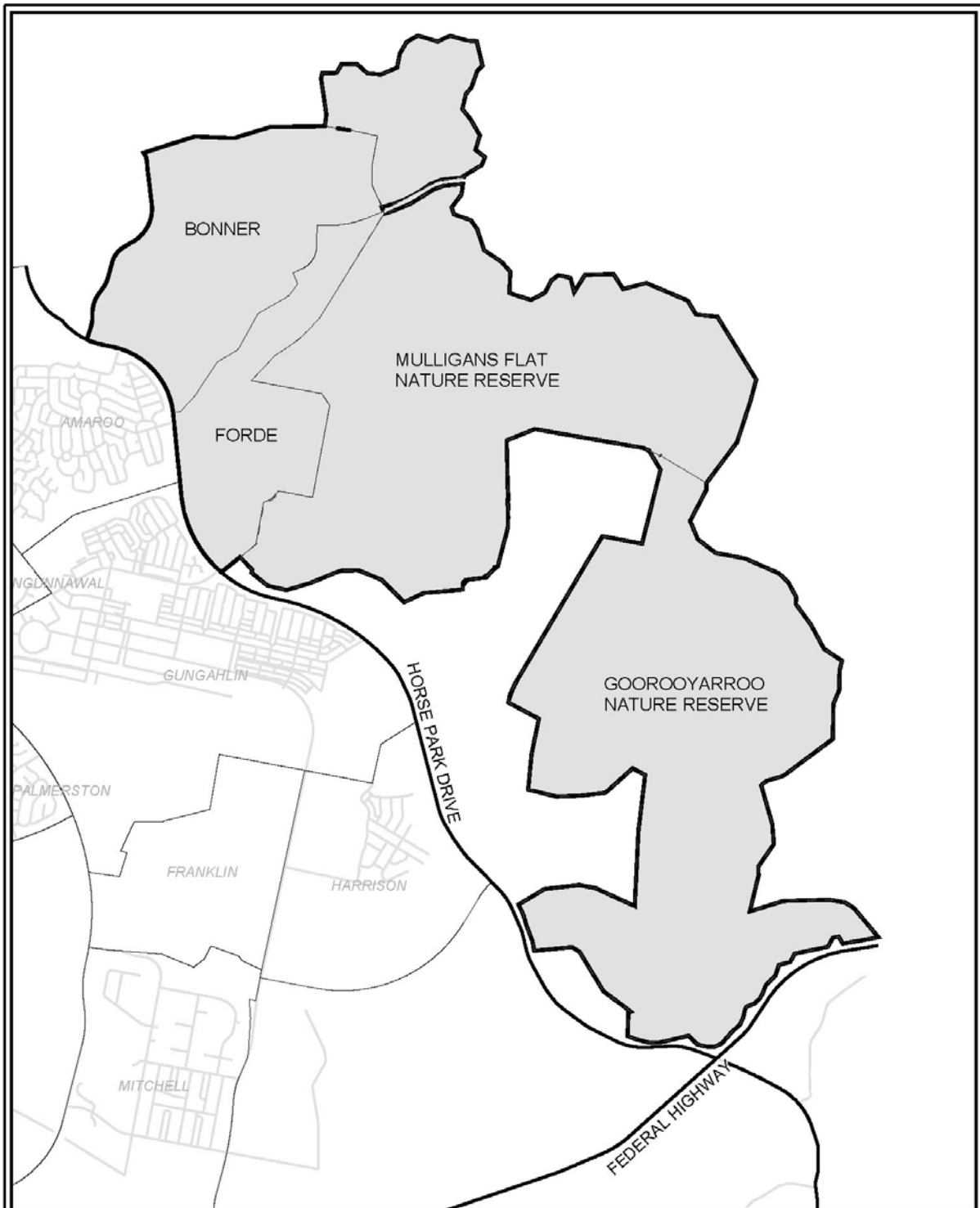
