1 Name

This determination is the Attorney-General (Determination of Fees and Charges for 2003/2004) Amendment 2004 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This determination commences the day after notification on the Legislation Register.

3 Instrument Amended

This instrument amends the Determination of Fees and Charges for 2003/2004 – Attorney General (DI 2003-90) as amended.

4 Amendments

Amend item 248 to read: “For the issue of a licence certificate, or of annual renewal of a licence certificate, under section 38 of the *Agents Act 2003*, for a travel agent, for a period of up to 12 months. A nominated director of a travel agency applying for or holding a corporate licence is exempt from paying this fee.”

Amend item 249 to read: “For the issue of a licence certificate, or of annual renewal of a licence certificate, under section 38 of the *Agents Act 2003*, for an employment agent, for a period of up to 12 months. A nominated director of an employment agency applying for or holding a corporate licence is exempt from paying this fee.”
